

# Lee Sinje pregnant with twin boys

MAJOR Chinese dailies reported that Malaysian singer-actress Lee Sinje (*pic*) was carrying a pair of twin boys.

*Sin Chew Daily* reported she made the announcement at a charity movie screening event organised by her Little Yellow Flower Foundation in Kuala Lumpur on Saturday.

"I'm very happy to be able to attend this meaningful event with my two babies today, giving is better than receiving and I think this is the best pre-natal education for them," she said.

She revealed she would be giving birth in Malaysia and that her hus-

band, film director Oxide Pang, would be here to accompany her.

> Ten stones on display at a temple in Sungai Besar, Selangor, purportedly spin when someone steps on them, *Sin Chew Daily* reported.

The stones were collected by the Ling Shi Gong Temple from jungles in China, Thailand, Taiwan and Malaysia, it reported.

Temple chairman Li Qiu Shui said about 300 people had tried to step on the stones and 70% of them could feel the stones spinning.
